Camp Details

Camp features include: An expert staff of coaches, daily practice sessions with camp coaches, team building exercises, sign up skill sessions for individual skills, live demonstrations of team drills, guarantee of at least 12 matches, Championship Monday - the culmination of the weeks competitors. Teams are required to have a minimum of **8 players**.

Colorado State's team camp has received praise as one of the finest camps of its kind. The team camp offers a great opportunity for your team to work on the skills and systems you plan to use this coming fall. It will allow you to bring your team together prior to the start of preseason and get a jumpstart on team concepts.

Colorado State is one of the nation's top volleyball programs. The Rams have appeared in **16 consecutive NCAA** tournaments and have **won at least 20 matches** in 16 straight seasons. CSU has produced **eight All-Americans** and has captured **12 Mountain West conference championships** since 1999.

Under Jesse's leadership, the Rams have become one of the top middle attacking and blocking teams in the country. He is also the Rams' recruiting coordinator. Mahoney was the head coach at Fort Hays State for six seasons from 1999-2004.

Bri Frech enters her fifth season as a part of the CSU coaching staff. Bri has been the camp director since 2008 and handles most of CSU's scouting and match preparations. Frech was a full-time starter for the Rams from 2003-04 and earned all-conference and all-tournament honors. She played professionally in France in 2006.
